

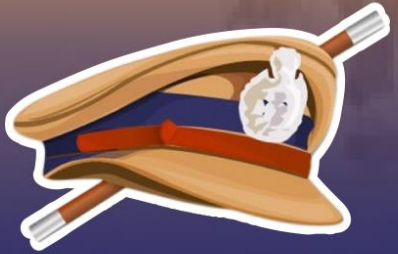

First Schedule

- **First Schedule (Articles 1 and 4) – Lists India's states and territories, changes in their borders and the laws used to make that change.**

Second Schedule

- Contains provisions as to the President, Governor of States, Speaker and Deputy Speaker of Lok Sabha and the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman of Rajya Sabha, the Speaker and Deputy Speaker of the Legislative Assembly and the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman of Legislative Council of State, the Judge of the Supreme Court and of the High Courts and the Comptroller and Auditor General on India.

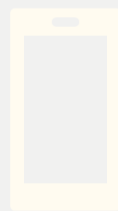

Third Schedule

- **Forms of oaths – Lists the oaths of office for elected officials and judges**





Fourth Schedule

- Details the allocation of seats in the Rajya Sabha (upper house of Parliament) by state or union territory.



Fifth Schedule

- Provides for the administration and control of Scheduled Areas[f] and Scheduled Tribes[g] (areas and tribes requiring special protection).



Sixth Schedule

- **Provisions made for the administration of tribal areas in Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura, and Mizoram.**

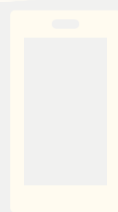

- Central government, state, and concurrent lists of responsibilities.



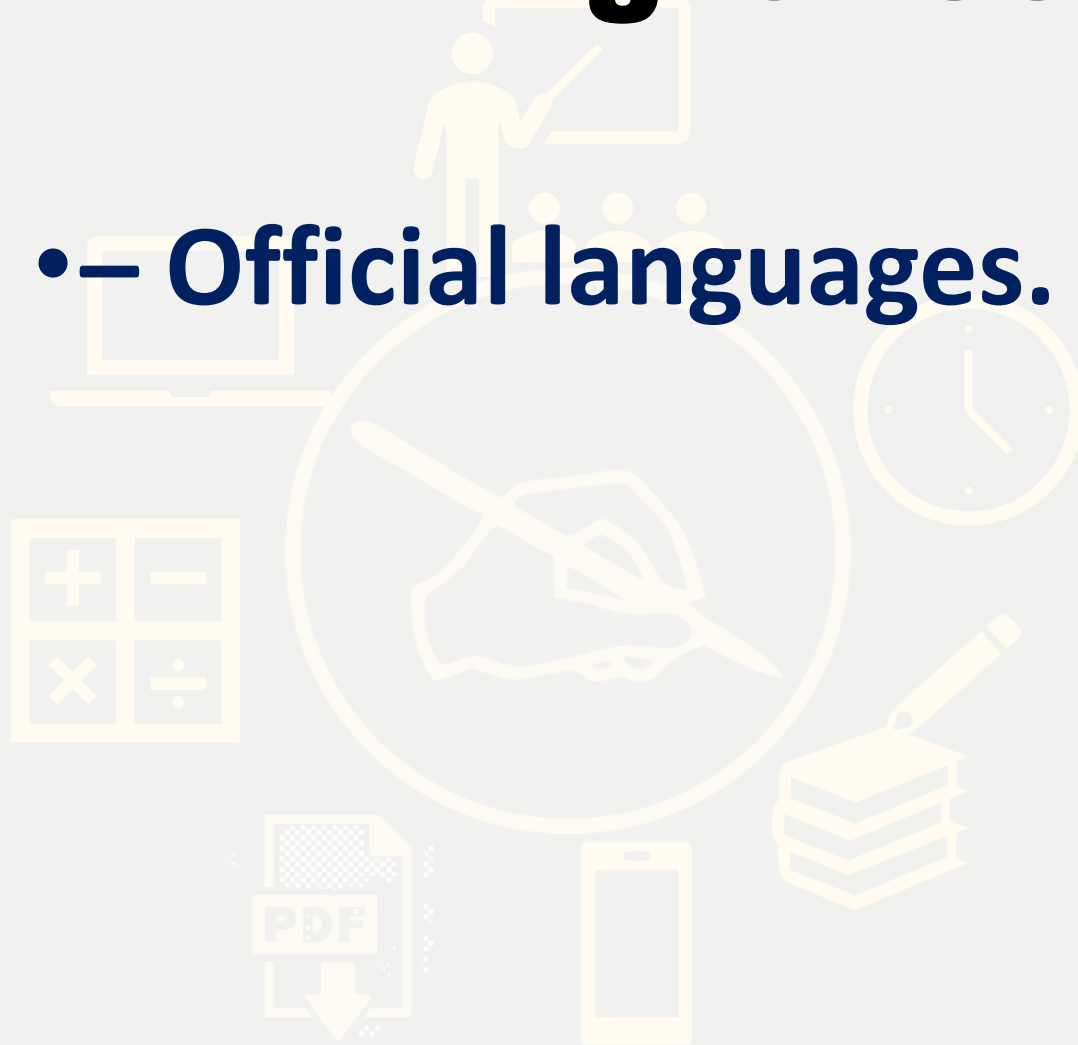

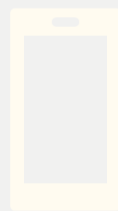
Ninth Schedule
