Certain phrases like- had better, had rather, would rather, would better, more than- are used with direct infinitives. "without to".

2. The scientists claim to discover cure to AIDS and the medicine will be put on sale very soon.

Ans- to have discovered.

Rule for – PERFECT INFINITIVE

Verbs – deny, confess, claim, admit, recollect, remember etc. are used with Perfect Infinitive.

### VERBS

- ✓ She denied to have seen him yesterday.
- ✓ He appears to have been rich earlier.
- ✓ She did not dare enter the room without his permission.
- ✓ She did not dare to enter the room without his permission.
- ✓ She was confident to qualify the examination.
- ✓ She was confident of qualifying the examination.
3. The civilians were Prohibited to attend the shooting competition in the Military area
- Ans- from attending.
4. You are requested to carefully carry the bag because it contains fragile material.
- Ans- To carry the bag carefully.
5. She was forbidden from moving out with her friends.
- Ans.- Forbidden to move out
6. He can't tolerate/bear anybody talking nonsense.
- Ans.- anybody's talking nonsense
7. He is understood to leave India for good last year.
- Ans- To have left India, rule of PERFECT INFINITIVE.
8. In spite of being a miser everybody likes to spend money on her.
- Ans- Although she is a miser.
9. Cooking my dinner in the kitchen a strange sound attracted my attention.
- Ans- While I was cooking dinner.
