scold

Synonyms: reprimand, rebuke

Antonyms: praise, commend

Example Sentence:

She admonished me for appearing at breakfast unshaven.

in abundance.

Synonyms: aplenty, in profusion

Antonyms: scarce

Example Sentence:

There were prizes galore for everything.

## 8. CAPRICIOUS

(ADJECTIVE): (मनमौजी): changeable

Synonyms: fickle, inconstant

Antonyms: stable, consistent

Example Sentence:

The state has a capricious and often brutal administration.

## 9. ABROGATE (VERB): (अभिनिषेध

करना): repudiate

Synonyms: revoke, repeal

Antonyms: institute, introduce

Example Sentence:

Engagements were binding, and then proceeded to abrogate this particular engagement.

## 10. RESILIENCE (NOUN): (लचीलता):

flexibility

Synonyms: pliability, elasticity

Antonyms: rigidity, fragility

Example Sentence:

She has shown great resilience to stress.
