RULE 9:

When a group acts as a singular unit, the verb should be singular; when they doesn't act as singular unit, the verb should be plural.

- ☐ **The **committee has/have** agreed to submit its report on Friday.**
- ☐ **The **board of directors meet/meets** once in a month.**
- ☐ **The **committee was/were** not in agreement on the action to be taken.**



ARTICLE

TYPES OF ARTICLE

Indefinite Article	A or An	It leaves indefinite the person or thing spoken of as : A doctor, A school - here 'A' points out any doctor, any school or any man or woman. Used only for countable noun.
Definite Article	The	It normally points out some particular person or thing as : He saw the doctor - where 'the' points out some particular doctor. Used for both countable/uncountable noun.

A or An :

The choice between 'a' and 'an'.

An:	Before a word beginning with a vowel sound.
A:	Before a word beginning with a consonant sound.
E.g:	an egg, an orange, a man, a school A and An are used with the singular number only.

1. When the proper noun is **well known/famous** + it has a **qualifier/title** attached with it, than only we can use the article **"THE"**.
2. When a proper noun is used as a **comparison** for a common noun + the **area/periphery** is specified, than only we can use the article **"THE"**.

RULES:

1. Use *the* with names of geographical areas, rivers, mountain ranges, groups of islands, canals, and oceans.

Exception- never use 'the' with mountain peaks.

2. Use *the* with countries that have plural names.
