



1- The China-India Media Summit Forum was held on August 12 in Beijing.

2- Aishwarya Pissay became the first Indian to claim a world title in motorsports, annexing the FIM World Cup (Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme) in the women's category after the final round of the championship at Varpalota in Hungary.
