



1- Jio overtakes Vodafone Idea as largest Indian telco by users. Billionaire Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Jio has overtaken Vodafone Idea to become India's largest telecom operator by subscribers in the June quarter.

2- Meghalaya Assembly Speaker and former Chief Minister Donkumar Roy passed away at the age of 64 on Sunday.

3- West Bengal Chief Minister and TMC supremo Mamata Banerjee has launched an outreach program 'Didi Ke Bolo' (Tell Didi), through which people can call the helpline number to complain or give suggestions.

4- PNB Housing Finance has raised \$100 million (nearly ₹690 crore) from World Bank Group member International Finance Corporation (IFC) to provide loans for affordable housing projects.

5- Egan Bernal became the youngest Tour de France winner in 110 years after completing the last stage of the competition. The 22-year-old Egan Bernal is also the first-ever Colombian to win the Tour de France title. Overall, Bernal is the third-youngest winner in the history of Tour de France behind Henri Cornet and François Faber.
