Answer- (c) Use ‘solve’ instead of ‘to solve’

4. His enmity with (a)/ the boss was what (b)/ led his to resign. (c)/ No Error (d)

Answer- (c) use ‘him’ not ‘his’

5. Raja Ram Mohan Roy tried to eradicate (a)/ social evils with (b)/ tooth and nail. (c)/ No error (d)

Answer- (b) Remove ‘with’

6. The student came to the classroom (a)/ lately and was punished (b)/ by the teacher. (c)/ No error (d)

Answer- (b) Use ‘late’ instead of ‘lately’ (lately means recently)

7. Parents are the (a)/ ultimate role models (b)/ to children. (c)/ No Error (d)

Answer- (c) use ‘for’ instead of ‘to’

8. He looks full of energy (a)/ today because he (b)/ soundly slept last night. (c)/ No error (d)

Answer- (c) Use ‘slept soundly’

9. You have (a)/ acted nobler (b)/ than all of us (c)/ No error (d)

Answer-(b) Use ‘more nobly’ instead of ‘nobler’

10. It is better to be frugal (a)/ but don’t be miser (b)/ in giving alms. (c)/ No error (d)

Answer- (b) Use ‘miserly’ instead of ‘miser’
