

1. ACQUISITION (NOUN): obtaining
Synonyms: gain, receiving
Antonyms: loss, failure
Example Sentence: There was an acquisition among travel agents.

2. HOSTILITY (NOUN): antagonism
Synonyms: aggression, meanness
Antonyms: friendship, goodwill
Example Sentence: Their hostility is to all outsiders.

3. EVOKE (VERB): induce
Synonyms: arouse, stimulate
Antonyms: calm, repress
Example Sentence: She is evoked in India when a house is being built to ensure its completion.

4. RESUSCITATE (VERB): revive
Synonyms: energise, invigorate
Antonyms: destroy, bore
Example Sentence: An ambulance crew tried to resuscitate him.

5. ADVERSARIAL (ADJECTIVE): opposing
Synonyms: adverse, antipathetic
Antonyms: agreeable, friendly
Example Sentence: I faced the adversarial nature of the party candidates.

6. REVOCATION (NOUN): annulment
Synonyms: abrogation, cancellation
Antonyms: approval, confirmation
Example Sentence: For those who break the law, revocation of their business license may result.

7. IMPUNITY (NOUN): freedom
Synonyms: immunity, exception
Antonyms: denial, prohibition
Example Sentence:

The impunity enjoyed by them implicated in animals killing.

8. INDELIBLE (ADJECTIVE):
indestructible
Synonyms: enduring, lasting
Antonyms: strong, healthy
Example Sentence: The story made an indelible impression on me.

9. SPEARHEAD (VERB): lead
Synonyms: initiate, launch
Antonyms: end, finish
Example Sentence: He is spearheading a campaign to reduce the number of accidents at work.

10. IMPOUND (VERB): confine
Synonyms: imprison, seize
Antonyms: free, let go
Example Sentence: Unfortunately, those people will be impounded in the prison.
