Synonyms: modernize, overhaul

Antonyms: break, damage

Example Sentence:

As an artist, I am always searching flea markets for junk that I can refurbish.

2. RUSE (NOUN): (चाल): feint

Synonyms: trick, deception

Antonyms: honesty, frankness

Example Sentence:

The security guard knew the girls were going to try and use a distractive ruse in order to shoplift.

3. SUPPLE (ADJECTIVE): (लचीला/सहज

में झुकनेवाला): flexible

Synonyms: elastic, agile

Antonyms: awkward, unpliable

Example Sentence:

It is important to stretch before exercise to keep a supple form.

4. JUNK (NOUN): (कचरा): garbage

Synonyms: debris, rubble

Antonyms: neatness, sterility

Example Sentence:

All his emails were gone to the junk.

5. TRIAL (ADJECTIVE): (प्रायोगिक):

experimental

Synonyms: exploratory, preliminary

Antonyms: definite, proven

Example Sentence:

It was in a trial session.

6. UNEARTH (VERB): (खोजकर

निकालना): dig up

Synonyms: discover, excavate

Antonyms: conceal, cover

Example Sentence:

"workmen unearthed an ancient artillery shell".

7. VENT (VERB): (जाने देना): release

Synonyms: emit, let out

Antonyms: hold, retain

Example Sentence:

I vented a shriek when the dog suddenly jumped on me.

8. DIMINUTIVE (ADJECTIVE): (छोटा):

tiny

Synonyms: petite, pint-sized

Antonyms: big, enormous

Example Sentence:

Sagarika is feeling diminutive hunger right now.

9. SINISTER

(ADJECTIVE): (अशुभ): evil

Synonyms: dire, devilish

Antonyms: angelic, divine

Example sentence:

He is a sinister person.

10. EFFETE (ADJECTIVE): (अशक्त):

spoiled

Synonyms: burnt up, corrupt

Antonyms: capable, tireless

Example Sentence:

Anhayraj is an effete kid.
