

1. CUMBERSOME (ADJECTIVE): (पेचीदा)

) complicated

Synonyms: complex, tangled

Antonyms: direct, simple

Example Sentence:

It is hard to solve the question because a convoluted reasoning is applied in it.

2. CREDENCE (NOUN): (विश्वास)

acceptance or belief

Synonyms: trust, assurance

Antonyms: denial, disbelief

Example Sentence:

I cannot give credence to his account.

3. CREED (NOUN): (मत) belief

Synonyms: principles, doctrine

Antonyms: disbelief, doubt

Example Sentence:

The centre is open to all, no matter what race or creed.

4. BLEND (NOUN): (मिश्रण) amalgam

Synonyms: fusion, combination

Antonyms: division, separation

Example Sentence:

College fests are now a great blend of cultural representation and musical concerts.

5. REFUGE (NOUN): (शरणस्थान) A

place of shelter

Synonyms: asylum, sanctuary

Antonyms: hazard, harmful place

Example Sentence:

The escaped prisoner sought refuge in the church.

6. SOLE (ADJECTIVE): (एकमात्र) Alone

Synonyms: exclusive, lone

Antonyms: combined, mixed

Example Sentence:

Success is a sole motive of my life.

7. AVERSE (ADJECTIVE): (प्रतिकूल)

opposing

Synonyms: hesitant, hostile

Antonyms: kind, loving

Example Sentence:

As a former Chief-Director, he is not averse to secrecy.

8. SENILITY (NOUN): (बुढ़ापा)

senescence

Synonyms: decrepitude, dotage

Antonyms: infancy, adolescence

Example Sentence:

He is suffering from senility.

9. IMPUGN (VERB): (प्रतिवाद करना)

Challenge

Synonyms: assail, question

Antonyms: concede, praise

10. DORMANT (ADJECTIVE): (निष्क्रिय)

Inactive

Synonyms: lurking, quiescent
