

The Hindu Vocabulary - 09.09.2017

1. DAUB (VERB): deface

Synonyms: smear, smudge

Antonyms: cleanse, purify

Example Sentence:

The criminal daubed the victim's face.

2. YEARNING (NOUN): desire

Synonyms: aspiration, craving

Antonyms: apathy, distaste

Example Sentence:

I have a yearning to crack the IBPS PO examination.

3. INCUR (VERB): bring upon oneself

Synonyms: obtain, acquire

Antonyms: forfeit, lose

Example Sentence:

The retiree was able to pull out his funds early, but he did incur a fee when doing so.

4. GUSHING (ADJECTIVE): *flowing*

Synonyms: spouting, pouring out

Antonyms: stagnant, frozen

Example Sentence:

Abuses were gushing from his mouth like hell.

5. PERISH (VERB): *decay*

Synonyms: rot, expire

Antonyms: improve, rise

Example Sentence:

This chemical will eventually perish sometime today.

6. BANTER (NOUN): *teasing*

Synonyms: jeering, ridicule

Antonyms: flattery, praise

Example Sentence:

His t-shirt had some banter line written over it.

7. EXTENSIVELY (ADVERB): *widely*

Synonyms: broadly, greatly

Antonyms: minutely, marginally

Example Sentence:

The demonetisation scheme benefitted the masses extensively.

8. COINCIDE (VERB): go along with

Synonyms: concur, harmonize

Antonyms: deviate, dissent

Example Sentence:

I can coincide with his idea.

9. PSEUDONYM (NOUN): false name

Synonyms: nick name, alias

Antonyms: real name, authentic name

Example Sentence:

All the characters in the play used their pseudonym.

10. VANITY (NOUN): egotism

Synonyms: conceitedness, ostentation

Antonyms: humility, modesty

Example Sentence:

It flattered his vanity to think I was in love with him.
