

1. GRACIOUS (ADJECTIVE): kind

Synonyms: generous, amicable

Antonyms: ungenial, ungracious

Example Sentence:

God is gracious.

2. GROUSE (NOUN): complaint

Synonyms: gripe, grouch

Antonyms: compliment, praise

Example Sentence:

I have no grouse against anyone for the misfortunes of life.

3. HUMDRUM (ADJECTIVE): dull

Synonyms: monotonous, boring

Antonyms: bright, exciting

Example Sentence:

After strenuous years of service he is not able to adapt himself to humdrum life of retirement.

4. HUDDLE (VERB): crowd together

Synonyms: assemble, collect

Antonyms: disband, disperse

Example Sentence:

They huddled around the stove to get warm.

5. DAEMON (NOUN): demon

Synonyms: devil, vampire

Antonyms: angel, God

Example Sentence:

He looks like a daemon.

6. ALLAY (VERB): solace

Synonyms: comfort, soothe

Antonyms: irritate, agitate

Example Sentence:

She allayed them.

7. GRAPPLE (VERB): wrestle

Synonyms: encounter, attack

Antonyms: avoid, dodge

Example Sentence:

Aman is taught to grapple his opponent.

8. RELISH (VERB): cherish

Synonyms: admire, enjoy

Antonyms: dislike, hate

Example Sentence:

I relished coffee at cafeteria.

9. JUNCTURE (NOUN): critical moment

Synonyms: condition, circumstance

Antonyms: blessing, advantage

Example Sentence:

At this juncture of life you must be wary of strangers.

10. IRONIC (ADJECTIVE): sarcastic

Synonyms: arrogant, mocking

Antonyms: straight, sincere

Example Sentence:

There was an ironic counterpoint buried in the music and lyrics.
