



### 1. MAJESTIC (ADJECTIVE):

(प्रभावशाली): exalted

Synonyms: august, great

Antonyms: pitiful

Example Sentence:

A majestic oak, one of the finest trees in the Forest, stands near it.

### 2. CURTAILMENT (NOUN):

(कटौती): reduction

Synonyms: cut, cutback

Antonyms: increase

Example Sentence:

The curtailment of human rights is the worst thing to do.

### 3. INCONCLUSIVE (ADJECTIVE):

(अनिर्णित): indecisive

Synonyms: indefinite, indeterminate

Antonyms: conclusive

Example Sentence:

They kept on doing inconclusive negotiations for three years.

### 4. RESUMPTION (NOUN):

Synonyms: restarting, reopening

Antonyms: suspension

Example Sentence:

The rain has stopped, but we're still waiting for the resumption of the game.

### 5. DWINDLE (VERB):

(क्षीण होना): diminish

Synonyms: decrease, reduce

Antonyms: increase

Example Sentence:

Traffic has dwindled to a trickle.

### 6. UNWITTING (ADJECTIVE):

(अनिच्छित): unintentional

Synonyms: unintended, inadvertent

Antonyms: deliberate

Example Sentence:

We are anxious to rectify the unwitting mistakes made in the past.

### 7. SHELVE (VERB): (टालना):

lay aside

Synonyms: pigeonhole, stay

She was going through a traumatic divorce.

**Antonyms:** carry out

**Example Sentence:**

Plans to reopen the school have been shelved.

**8. VIGILANT (ADJECTIVE):**

**(जागरूक): watchful**

**Synonyms:** observant, sharp-eyed

**Antonyms:** negligent

**Example Sentence:**

The burglar was spotted by vigilant neighbours.

**9. EXALT (VERB):**

**(प्रशंसा करना): glorify**

**Synonyms:** extol, praise

**Antonyms:** disparage

**Example Sentence:**

The party will continue to exalt their hero.
