1301. **Otiose (adj)**
Meaning:- lazy (आलसी)
Key:- होती ओस
Trick:- होती ओस तो इतना Otiose नहीं होता वो |
Example:- Women with otiose husbands have a task to preserve friendship.
1302. **Internecine (adj)**
Meaning:- involving conflict within a group (परस्पर-विध्वंसी)
Key:- इंटर में sign
Trick:- इंटर में sign करा लिया था उसने मेरे से मेरी प्रॉपर्टी के लिए जिससे हमारे बीच Internecine रहता है |
Example:- The region's history of savage internecine warfare.
1303. **Tocsin (n)**
Meaning:- an alarm bell or signal (खतरे का घंटा)
Key:- talk sin
Trick:- talk अबाउट sin is tocsin.
Example:- He used his resignation as a tocsin to warn of the danger of dictatorship.
1304. **Paramour (n)**
Meaning:- lover (प्रेमिका)
Key:- पूरा मोर
Trick:- पूरा मोर के जैसी दिखती है मेरी Paramour.
Example:- The king himself now asserts it was because he had tried to seduce his paramour.
1305. **Jejune (adj)**
Meaning:- immature (अरोचक)
Key:- जीजू ने
Trick:- जीजू ने Jejune काम कर डाला |
Example:- Their entirely predictable and usually jejune opinions.
1306. **Nostalgic (adj)**
Meaning:- feeling, evoking, or characterized by nostalgia (उदासीन)
Key:- नास्ता
Trick:- नास्ता आकर रख गया फिर भी वो Nostalgic बना रहा |
Example:- He remained nostalgic about the good old days.
1307. **Impending (v)**
Meaning:- be about to happen (निकट का)
Key:- pending
Trick:- पढाई pending है और एजाम Impending.
Example:- My impending departure.
1308. **Catastrophic (adj)**
Meaning:- destructive (आपत्तिजनक)
Key:- कैट को ट्राफी
Trick:- कैट को ट्राफी दिया तो Catastrophic होगा |
Example:- A catastrophic earthquake.
1309. **Deteriorate (v)**
Meaning:- become progressively worse (बिगड़ना)
Key:- देते इस रेट
Trick:- दे देते इस रेट पे तो बर्युँ होती बात Deteriorate.
Example:- Relations between the countries had deteriorated sharply.
1310. **Barter (v)**
Meaning:- exchange anything without using money (अदल-बदल करना)
Key:- बाहर
Trick:- बाहर जाकर अपने सामान को उसके सामान से Barter कर लो |
Example:- He often bartered a meal for drawings.
1311. **Flout (v)**
Meaning:- openly disregard (उपहास)
Key:- फ्लो
Trick:- फ्लो फ्लो में उसने सब के सामने उसका Flout कर दिया |
Example:- The advertising code is being flouted.
1312. **Gutted (adj)**
Meaning:- bitterly disappointed or upset (निराश)
Key:- गलत
Trick:- गलत काम करने के बाद वो Gutted था |
Example:- I know how gutted the players must feel.
1313. **Plod (v)**
Meaning:- walk doggedly and slowly with heavy steps (धीरे धीरे चलना)
Key:- प्लाट
Trick:- ये प्लाट थोड़ा स्लिपरी है, धीरे धीरे चलना |
Example:- We plodded back up the hill.
1314. **Envision (v)**
Meaning:- imagine as a future possibility; visualize (कल्पना करना)
Key:- इनके विज़न
Trick:- इनके विज़न Envision करो, कामयाब हो जाओगे |
Example:- She envisioned the admiring glances of guests seeing her home.
1315. **Gaiety (n)**
Meaning:- happiness, celebration (उल्लास)
Key:- गेट
Trick:- गेट के पास बहुत ही Gaiety माहौल है |
Example:- The sudden gaiety of children's laughter.
1316. **Bravado (n)**
Meaning:- a bold manner intended to impress (वाहवाही)
Key:- ब्रेव
Trick:- ब्रेव लोग ही Bravado कमाते हैं |
Example:- He possesses none of the classic wheeler-dealer's casual bravado.
1317. **Flare (v)**
Meaning:- burn or shine with a sudden intensity (भड़कना)
Key:- फ्लेवर
Trick:- फ्लेवर खराब होने से वो Flare हो गया |
Example:- The bonfire crackled and flared up.
1318. **Flounder (v)**
Meaning:- struggle or stagger clumsily in mud or water (कीचड़ में तड़फड़ाना)
Key:- फाउंडर
Trick:- FB का फाउंडर कीचड़ में Flounder हो रहा |
Example:- He was floundering about in the shallow offshore waters.
1319. **Gaffe (n)**
Meaning:- mistake, a blunder goof (गलती)
Key:- कैफे
Trick:- इस कैफे में आना उसकी सबसे बड़ी Gaffe थी |
Example:- In my first few months at work I made some real gaffes.
1320. **Goof (n/v)**
Meaning:- a foolish or stupid person; make a mistake (मूर्ख, गलती करना)
Key:- गुफा
Trick:- गुफा में Goof लोग रहते हैं |
Example:- Someone at the bank had goofed.
1321. **Elude (v)**
Meaning:- avoid; escape (बचना)
Key:- ई दुदे
Trick:- ई दुदे से सभी को Elude होना पड़ेगा |
Example:- He tried to elude the security men by sneaking through a back door.
1323. **Arriviste (n)**
Meaning:- newly rich (धनवान)
Key:- अरीवीस्ट
Trick:- अरीवीस्ट नाम का इंसान बहुत ही Arriviste है |
Example:- Smith writing an article for an arriviste Priyanka Chopra.

1322. **Jibe (n)**
Meaning:- an insulting or mocking remark; a taunt (उपहास)
Key:- जाइब
Trick:- हम उहाँ न जाइब, वो हमारा Jibe करते हैं |
Example:- A jibe at his old rivals.

1324. **Recusant (n)**
Meaning:- a person who refuses to submit to an authority (विरोध)
Key:- रुको संत
Trick:- रुको, संत का Recusant मत करो |
Example:- A Recusant is not allowed here.

1325. **Turpitude (n)**
Meaning:- depraved or wicked behaviour (नीचता, अधमता)
Key:- तार पे चले
Trick:- तार पे चल कर नीचता वाला काम किया है |
Example:- Acts of moral turpitude.
