1326. **Gruesome (adj)**
Meaning:- horrible, awful (भयानक)
Key:- गुरु some
Trick:- some गुरु Gruesome होते हैं |
Example:- The most gruesome murder.
1327. **Miniature (adj)**
Meaning:- tiny (छोटा)
Key:- मिनी
Trick:- मिनी = Miniature
Example:- Children dressed as miniature adults.
1328. **Unscrupulous (adj)**
Meaning:- immoral (बेशरम)
Key:- अन्नास
Trick:- अन्नास बेचने वाला बहुत ही Unscrupulous है |
Example:- Unscrupulous landlords might be tempted to harass existing tenants.
1329. **Allude (v)**
Meaning:- hint at (संकेत करना)
Key:- ए dude
Trick:- ए dude बोलकर उसने उसे Allude किया |
Example:- She had a way of alluding to Jean but never saying her name.
1330. **Grievous (adj)**
Meaning:- severe, painful; serious (कष्टकर)
Key:- गरीब
Trick:- गरीब के लिए चीजें Grievous होती हैं |
Example:- His death was a grievous blow.
1331. **Juvenile (adj)**
Meaning:- childish; immature. (किशोर)
Key:- जुंवे
Trick:- जुंवे हमेशा Juvenile को ही पड़ती है |
Example:- She's bored with my juvenile conversation.
1332. **Mortgage (n)**
Meaning:- loan agreement (गिरवी)
Key:- more गज
Trick:- more गज जमीन Mortgage पर रख दी |
Example:- A company which provide loan against mortgage of farm land etc.
1333. **Emasculate (v)**
Meaning:- make (someone or something) weaker or less effective (प्रभावहीन)
Key:- ई masculine (man)
Trick:- ई masculine Emasculate हो चुका है |
Example:- The refusal to allow them to testify effectively emasculated the committee.
1334. **Objurgate (v)**
Meaning:- rebuke severely; scold. (डॉटना)
Key:- आप जोर से गेट
Trick:- आपने जोर से गेट पर मुझे Objurgate किया था |
Example:- The old man objurgated his son.
1335. **Descry (v)**
Meaning:- discover (पता लगा लेना)
Key:- देश cry
Trick:- देश cry क्यों किया, मैंने Descry कर लिया |
Example:- She descryed two figures.
1336. **Peculiar (adj)**
Meaning:- particular; special. (विशेष, अनोखा)
Key:- पीकू
Trick:- पीकू बहुत ही Peculiar इंसान है |
Example:- Any attempt to explicate the theme is bound to run into peculiar difficulties.
1337. **Inure (v)**
Meaning:- accustom (आदी बनाना)
Key:- इनो
Trick:- इनो ने सभी को अपना बना Inure लिया |
Example:- These children have been inured to violence.
1338. **Demarche (n)**
Meaning:- a political step or initiative. (कार्यवाही)
Key:- दिमाक
Trick:- दिमाक खराब मत करो, इसपर Demarche करो |
Example:- Foreign policy demarche.
1339. **Shenanigans (n)**
Meaning:- secret or dishonest activity or manoeuvring; mischief (छल-कपट)
Key:- सेना ने गन से
Trick:- सेना ने गन से सब Shenanigans करने वालों को शूट कर दिया |
Example:- The chairman was accused of financial shenanigans.
1340. **Menagerie (n)**
Meaning:- a collection of wild animals kept in captivity for exhibition; zoo (वन्य पशुशाला)
Key:- मीना जी
Trick:- मीना जी Menagerie घूमने जा रही |
Example:- I saw a lion which escaped from Menagerie.
1341. **Picayune (adj)**
Meaning:- trivial (तुच्छ)
Key:- P.K. जून
Trick:- P.K. जून में आया और Picayune काम किया |
Example:- If we were only there, our chances wouldn't be worth a picayune.
1342. **Winsome (adj)**
Meaning:- attractive or appealing in a fresh, innocent way (मनोहर)
Key:- Win some
Trick:- Win किया some लोगों का दिल बहुत ही Winsome तरीके से |
Example:- A winsome smile of her made me her fan.
1343. **Desiderate (v)**
Meaning:- desire (चाहना)
Key:- देशी डरे
Trick:- देशी डरेंगे जरूर अगर तुम चाहो |
Example:- A wide gulf between what they desiderate and what they deserve.
1344. **Narcissist (n)**
Meaning:- egotist (अहंकारी, आत्मरतिक)
Key:- नैन्सी सिस्टर

Trick- नैन्सी की सिस्टर बहुत ही Narcissist है |

Example:- Narcissists who think the world revolves around them.

1345. Ostracize (v)

Meaning:- exclude from a society or group (समाज से बाहर निकालना)

Key- ostrich

Trick- ostrich को Ostracize कर दिया गया जब वो गाँव में घुसा |

Example:- She was declared a witch and ostracized by the villagers.

1346. Solicitation (n)

Meaning:- proposal; asking (विनती)

Key- सोलें at स्टेशन

Trick- सोलें at स्टेशन, Solicitation है हमारा पुलिस साहब |

Example:- He was a regular target for solicitation of funds.

1347. Adamant (adj)

Meaning:- refusing to be persuaded or to change one's mind. (हठी)

Key:- एडम

Trick:- एडम बहुत ही Adamant है |

Example:- He is adamant that he is not going to resign.

1348. Emanate (v)

Meaning:- give out or emit (निकालना)

Key:- man ate

Trick:- man ने हाजमोला ate किया फर कुछ Emanate किया |

Example:- He emanated a powerful brooding air.

1349. Inevitably (adv)

Meaning:- unavoidably (अनिवार्य रूप से)

Key:- ई नेवी

Trick:- ई नेवी वाले हर काम को Inevitably रूप से करते हैं, टालते नहीं |

Example:- Inevitably some details are already out of date.

1350. Insidious (adj)

Meaning:- sneaky, tricky (कपटी)

Key:- CD

Trick:- CD वाले अब Insidious हो चुके हैं |

Example:- Sexual harassment is a serious and insidious problem.
