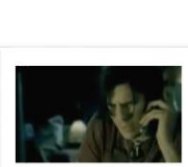
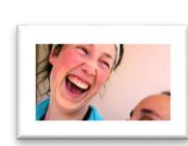
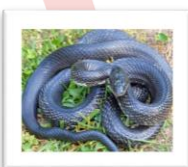
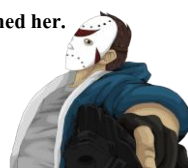
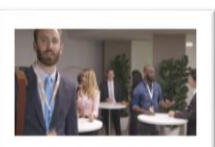
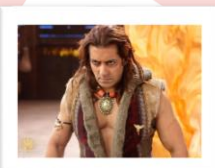
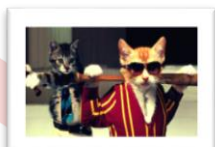
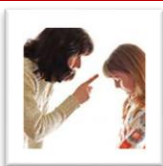


1625. **Impediment (n)**  
 Meaning:- obstruction, hindrance (अटकाव)  
 Key:- इन पे दी  
 Trick:- इन पे दी आ गयी और सारे काम में Impediment दाल दिया |  
 Example:- A serious impediment to scientific progress.
1627. **Inaccurate (adj)**  
 Meaning:- incorrect, Erroneous (ग़लत)  
 Key:- In + accurate  
 Trick:- accurate ये नहीं है, Inaccurate है |  
 Example:- False or inaccurate descriptions of goods.
1628. **Notorious (adj)**  
 Meaning:- famous with bad name (कुख्यात)  
 Key:- नोटों  
 Trick:- नोटों (Black money) को लेकर निरव मोदी Notorious हो गया |  
 Example:- Notorious people are not welcomed anywhere.
1629. **Ode (n)**  
 Meaning:- poem (कविता)  
 Key:- ODD  
 Trick:- ODD तरीके से Ode सुनाता है |  
 Example:- There are some beautiful poems on nature, particularly the magnificent ode to the Year's End.
1630. **Perseverance (n)**  
 Meaning:- diligence, hard work (अटलता)  
 Key:- परसों वीर से  
 Trick:- परसों वीर से मिला, बहुत ही Perseverance है |  
 Example:- His perseverance with the technique illustrates his single-mindedness.
1631. **Pervasive (adj)**  
 Meaning:- extensive (फैलती हुई)  
 Key:- पूरा वैसे  
 Trick:- पूरा वैसे ही फैलता चला गया |  
 Example:- Ageism is pervasive in our society.
1632. **Delinquent (adj)**  
 Meaning:- irresponsible, defaulting (अपराधी)  
 Key:- daily quant  
 Trick:- वो daily quant नहीं पढ़ता, कितना Delinquent है वो |  
 Example:- Delinquent teenagers.
1633. **Disputable (adj)**  
 Meaning:- debatable; open to discussion (विवादास्पद)  
 Key:- Dispute  
 Trick:- Dispute = Disputable  
 Example:- Whether it can be described as art criticism may be disputable.
1634. **Detain (v)**  
 Meaning:- hold, keep back; arrest (रोकना)  
 Key:- attain
1635. **Delirious (adj)**  
 Meaning:- mentally imbalanced (भ्रान्तचित्त)  
 Key:- daily  
 Trick:- daily कब तक चलेगा, Delirious हो गया हू |  
 Example:- He became delirious and couldn't recognize people.
1636. **Erratum (n)**  
 Meaning:- misprint (अशुद्धि)  
 Key:- Erase  
 Trick:- Erase करो इसे, Erratum है इसमें |  
 Example:- Don't make any erratum in typing.
1637. **Entail (v)**  
 Meaning:- require; result in (आवश्यक)  
 Key:- Cocktail  
 Trick:- Cocktail लेना Entail नहीं है |  
 Example:- A situation that entails considerable risks.
1638. **Engross (v)**  
 Meaning:- absorb all the attention or interest of (ध्यान खींचना)  
 Key:- grass  
 Trick:- grass में एक snake will engross you.  
 Example:- They seemed to be engrossed in conversation.
1639. **Entreaty (n)**  
 Meaning:- plea, humble request (निवेदन)  
 Key:- entry  
 Trick:- Entry के लिए बहुत ही Entreaty की |  
 Example:- He ignored her entreaties.
1640. **Fatalist (adj)**  
 Meaning:- submission to fate (भाग्यवादी)  
 Key:- fate  
 Trick:- उसकी fate अच्छी है इसलिए वो fatalist है |  
 Example:- The driver of the taxi was so fatalist that he did not receive injury.
1641. **Hasten (v)**  
 Meaning:- be quick to do something (जल्दी करना)  
 Key:- हँसे  
 Trick:- हँसे मत, थोरा Hasten करें |  
 Example:- He hastened to purchase this property.
1642. **Hinder (v)**  
 Meaning:- prevent, slow down (रोकना)  
 Key:- हरविंदर  
 Trick:- हरविंदर सिंह ने उसके काम में बहुत ही Hinder किया |  
 Example:- Don't try to hinder to run an institute.
1643. **Harass (v)**  
 Meaning:- subject to aggressive pressure (सताना)  
 Key:- हरी घास



Trick:- हरी घास के लिए उसे बहुत ही Harass किया गया |

Example:- Being harassed at work, he is now unable to work.

1644. Homogenous (adj)

Meaning:- similar, comparable (एक समान)

Key:- HOMO + जेंट्स

Trick:- HOMO + जेंट्स = Homogenous

Example:- The mixture formed in homogenous.



1645. Hostile (adj)

Meaning:- antagonistic (शत्रुतापूर्ण)

Key- hostel

Trick- hostel में Students में Hostile होता है |

Example:- A hostile support.



1646. Hexed (n/v)

Meaning:- a magic spell; a curse (जादू करना)

Key:- fixed

Trick:- fix है ये बात की

उसने Hexed किया है |

Example:- A death hex.



1647. Horrendous (adj)

Meaning:- terrible (खराब)

Key:- वो रहे दस

Trick:- वो रहे दस लोग जो Horrendous

दिखते हैं |

Example:- She suffered horrendous injuries.



1648. Incite (v)

Meaning:- encourage, provoke

(उत्तेजित करना)

Key:- इन साइट
